
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
ENROLLMENT CONTRACT FEE POLICY

Registration fee is \$150 and is in addition to the camp tuition fee of \$600.00.

Registration Fee. The Registration fee of \$150 covers camp supplies, photo session, one (1) camp t-shirt and one (1) Performance t-shirt.



Paid registration fees are non-refundable.



Early Bird Discount – Tuition is \$550 if paid by April 16, 2025.

Late Pick-up Fee. Camp ends at 3:00 p.m. daily. There is an additional \$1.00 per minute charge for late pick-up unless you have made aftercare arrangements with the camp. Aftercare fees are \$15.00 a day or \$50.00 for the week per camper and all campers in aftercare must be picked up no later than 4:30 p.m. All other campers must be picked up by 3:00 p.m.

Returned Check Fee. All checks returned due to insufficient funds will be charged \$35.00 and must be exchanged with cash, money order or debit card payment. 
